PABA Website User Documentation

1. How to login

- a. Go to the PABA webpage at www.ploverbiz.org
- b. A login will be displayed on the left side of the page
- c. For the first time logging in, contact PABA for a temporary password at (715) 345-5258 or paba@ploverbiz.org.
- d. Once the password is received, go back to the homepage, and enter the registered e-mail address and password. Click the "Login" button.

2. Change password

- a. To change the password, go to PABA's homepage. Click the "Edit Profile" button located in the login area.
- b. There will be an option near the top to change the password. Enter a new password and confirm it.
- c. While on this page, company information can be edited.
- d. When finished, scroll to the bottom of the page and click "Update".

3. How to add an event

- a. To add an event, log onto the PABA website.
- b. Click on the "Events" button located on the green bar at the top of the page.
- c. A calendar of events will be displayed. At the bottom of the calendar, click on "Add an event".
- d. A window will pop up with an editor that can be used for listing the event.
- e. On this first page, add all the event information.

Make sure the "Categories" option is always set to "Default".

- f. To set the date and time of the event, click on the "Calendar" tab at the top of the page.
- g. When finished, click the "Save" button on the top right of the window.
